Providing More Accessible Service: Online and Sunday Consultation Windows for Moving Procedures

March and April are busy seasons for the ward office due to an influx of visitors coming to settle moving procedures. We recommend using the online application service, or going to the special service counters (open Sundays and designated weekdays at night) to fill out your paperwork.

⇒Residents moving OUT of Kobe can fill out paperwork online or via post.

⇒Paperwork can be filed at your ward/branch office on Sundays or Thursdays, during extended office hours for moving procedures and MyNumber card applications.
