A City Where the People Write Their Own Stories: Redeveloping the City Center, Sannomiya

Downtown Sannomiya is undergoing renovations and redevelopments in order to create a “city where people write their own stories,” where pedestrians are the main focus. Below are some of the redevelopments being planned.

[Concept for Redevelopment]

・A “Gateway to the Beautiful Port City, Kobe” that naturally draws visitors into the city from the moment they step out of the station

・A comfortable city where people play a leading role



2027: New Bus Terminal

Set to accommodate approx. 1700 inter-city and long-distance buses per day, this new bus terminal is expected to be the largest in western Japan.



2029: Sannomiya Cross Square (Phase I)

Pedestrian spaces will be expanded, and foot traffic increased through better connecting the train stations to the downtown center to create a more bustling atmosphere.

First Care Package Content Includes: Baby goods, toys, picture books, vouchers for facilities and services, etc.

Subsequent Care Packages Include: Diapers, baby formula, baby food, etc.

You can choose from multiple items for each option.

Notifications will be mailed to eligible households in order starting from the end of October.

Switching to MyNa Health Insurance Cards

The government is planning on phasing out health insurance cards and replacing them with MyNumber Cards. Current health insurance cards will be valid until December 1, 2025, but **there will be NO new issuances or reissuances of current health insurance cards as of December 2, 2024.**

If you have not yet applied for a MyNumber card, or have not completed the health insurance registration procedures for your card, please consider doing so as soon as possible.

Registering the Health Insurance Card Function On Your MyNumber Card:

Required Items:

MyNumber card, and your 4-digit PIN (for digital certificates)

Where to Register:

① MyNa Portal
(Requires a smartphone that can read a MyNumber card)

② Seven Bank ATMs (24-hour service)

③ Ward Offices, Branch Offices*:

④ Sannomiya Center, Gakuentoshi Satellite Offices*:

Open Hours: Mon. to Wed.: 12:00~19:45,
